On 2nd June 2006, Barrow Borough Council adopted these proposals. The adopted proposals will form part of the development plan for the area of Barrow Borough Council. The development plan forms the basis for decisions on land use planning affecting that area.

The proposals came into operation on their adoption. A person aggrieved by the proposals who desires to question their validity on the ground that they are not within the powers conferred by Part II of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 or that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the proposals, may, within six weeks from 5th June 2006, make an application to the High Court under section 287 of the 1990 Act.
