



CORE DATA

You may have noticed when you sign up for a new tenancy that we are required to fill out a CORE (**C**ontinuous **R**ecording of Social Housing Lettings and Sales) form containing information relating to your tenancy, the dwelling you are living in and your household.

Under the new changes introduced under GDPR, we must make it clear to you why we are collecting this data and how we are using it.

CORE Data is collected on behalf of the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government (MHCLG) for research and statistical purposes only. We do not require the consent of tenants to provide the information but you do have the right to know how and for what purpose your data is being collected, held and used.

We are collecting and sharing your information to help us better understand the social housing market and inform social housing policy. It does not affect your benefits, services or treatments that you get. The information shared is anonymous and handled with care in accordance with the law.
