

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (FOOTPATH NO. 601037 IN THE PARISH OF BARROW-IN-FURNESS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2018

**WHEREAS** the County Council of Cumbria (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) being the traffic authority for Footpath No. 601037 in the Parish of Barrow-in-Furness is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said road should be restricted by reason of works being proposed to be executed thereon (“the Works”).

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order.

1. No person shall proceed along that section of Footpath No. 601037 in the Parish of Barrow-in-Furness between Grid Reference 318390 470141, extending in north westerly direction for a distance of approx. 28m to Grid Reference 318382 470168.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply other than at such times and to such extent as is indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the eighth day of January 2018 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Footpath No. 601037 in the Parish of Barrow-in-Furness) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2018.
