If no, what corrective action is required	X	Information required by regulator – CEM software recently upgraded but results reported are not appropriate although pollutant levels are compliant. Results that are produced are not averaged correctly, i.e. CO and Particulate readings show an average of 0 for a cremation, this is not an error- it is a bad average calculation of the readings, i.e. not averaged every 5mins, therfore readout is 'scewed' P.J. Combustable solutions has been aquired to rectify and upgrade software at cost. CEM Results Monthly & 6 Month Reports — All emission reports have been forwarded on time and the new 'layout report' has been forwarded since July 2014. No 6 Month reports have been received, however monthly reporting is up to date.
		Corrective Action / Recommendations
		1) The operator is to forward CEM reports for the last 6 months. - six monthly Emission Reports should be sent to the regulator at the beginning of January & July each year within the first 10 days of that month. (Although regulator notes that software programme cannot complete this action in the current mode.)
		2) The operator should inform the regulator when the upgrade to the computer software is completed, it would be advantageous to see if reports can be backdated and thus reproduced with

the appropriate averages etc.

3) In the event that no corrective measures to the 'software reporting system' have been carried out or the newly-installed software is not working accurately, then 'Catelyst' should be appointed to validate emmissions independently while the reporting system is not functional. This may be arranged in June/ July after further communication and consideration.

Other observations

- On inspection- Gas leak reported and engineer acquired to resolve issue.
- With current software, no 6 month reports can be produced and this issue remains until the upgrade has been completed.
- Manager reports that a 're-line' of cremators taking place on 17th April and should last for a few days.
- Manager reports that building is under going a design and alteration which will incorporate offices- this should have no effect on the daily running of the cremators.
- Manager reported new cremators in 2016/2017 and enquired about abatement.
