 Three tenders received for purchase of two new cremators with mercury abatement as standard. Works to start July 2018 with completion by 31st August 2018. Order to be placed by April 2018. Period of 6 weeks without cremators, most likely use Bentham cremators, Lancashire! Cameo still paid (£26000) and running up till 2019- therefore mercury abatement may not be used initially. New Equipment to be fitted with Internet/ WiFi uplink to manufacturer for fault diagnostic. Nearest property exists at gatehouse to cemetery- thus some 192 meters.
