BOROUGH OF BARROW-IN-FURNESS PUBLIC SPACE PROTECTION ORDER EXTENSION NO 1 of 2022

ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME & POLICING ACT 2014 PUBLIC SPACE PROTECTION ORDER NO. 1 2018

Barrow Borough Council has made the following extension and alteration to the Order under section 60, 61 and 72 in relation to the activities as set out in the Public Space Protection Order No. 1 2018 ("the original order). The original order came into force on 1 April 2019 and the extension comes into force on 22 March 2022.

Extension of Original Order

- 1. With the alteration at 2 below the original Order is extended with immediate effect, for a period of 3 years from the date of this order (22 March 2022).
- 2. The wording of Paragraph 2.1 (iii) of the original Order is substituted with the following wording;
 - iii) Nothing in this requirement applies to a person who
 - a) is registered as a blind person in a register complied under section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948; or
 - b) has a disability which affects his mobility, manual dexterity, physical coordination or ability to lift, carry or otherwise move everyday objects, in respect of a dog trained by any current or future members of Assistance Dogs UK or any other prescribed charity and upon which he relies for assistance.
 - The term "Assistance Dog" shall mean a dog which has been trained to assist a person with a disability,
 - The expression 'disability' shall have the meaning prescribed in Schedule 6
 of the Equality Act 2010 or as may be defined in any subsequent
 amendment or re-enactment of the legislation.

In all other respects the Order is as originally made.

- 3. The Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds the extension is necessary to prevent:
 - a. Occurrence or recurrence after that time of the activities identified in the order, or
 - b. An increase in the frequency or seriousness of those activities after that time
